DIRECTIONS

For those using satnav the postcode is DL5 6NL

Redworth Hall Hotel is approximately 3.5 miles off the A1(M) and may be reached by taking the A68 West Auckland/Corbridge road off the A1(M). At the first roundabout, turn right onto the A6072 Shildon Road. Carry straight on at the next roundabout, following signs for Redworth. Redworth Hall is on your left, 800 yards after the roundabout.

The hotel is approximately: 7 miles from Darlington
30 miles from Newcastle
59 miles from York

It is only minutes by car from the A1(M) and near to Teesside, Tyneside and Wearside. It is only a short drive from Darlington and from Durham Tees Valley International Airport.

ARRANGEMENTS

- The residential course fee includes all meals from tea break on Friday to lunch on Sunday. All the bedrooms have facilities for making tea and coffee, together with satellite television, telephone and computer point, hairdryer, and trouser press.
- Please note that fees paid by non-resident delegates do not include the cost of meals, apart from lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

- Registration for the conference is 12.45pm on Friday 2 March. Lunch on Friday is not included in the course fee but will be available in the hotel restaurant or lounge if required. Tea and coffee will be available on registration.
- All meals will be taken in the CONSERVATORY RESTAURANT, except for dinner on Saturday which will be in the THE GREAT HALL and Sunday lunch which will be taken in the 1744 ROOM (go through restaurant to get to it). Breakfast is served from 07.00 Saturday and 07.30 Sunday. If you have any particular dietary needs (e.g. vegetarian, gluten free) then please complete the relevant section of the food questionnaire, which will be handed out at registration.

- You must pay for your own drinks. “Happy Hour” bar prices will be available in the BARONIAL LOUNGE on Saturday night 19:00 to 20:00. Private telephone calls and extras must be paid for when checking out on Sunday.
- Dress throughout the course is informal.
- Name badges will be given out at registration. Please return these to a course officer at the end of the course.
- All lectures will take place in the PRINCE BISHOP SUITE. It will be appreciated if you would assemble promptly, before the stated times in the programme. Would you, please, ensure that there are no interruptions from mobile phones. By all means switch your phone to silent mode and Tweet during the conference using **#Redworth2018**.
- To assist non-residential delegates we now have lectures after lunch on Saturday. Free time is now from 16:00 on Saturday until Dinner on Saturday night. Drinks are from 19:00 however.
